## **IVF Treatment Timeline**

## The male is only required once to collect sperm;

We have the following options for the husband as below;

- 1. Male can come on the day of his wife's egg collection (OPU) to collect sperm fresh;
- 2. Male can come any time (with an appointment) prior to the egg collection, collect sperm, and have the sperm washed and frozen for future use (extra costs are involved),

For the female, while we cannot give you an exact timeline as the stimulation process is variable and dependent upon the female's response to stimulation, it will roughly go like;

- 1. Consultation on day 2 of menstruation, some blood tests and ultrasound, if everything is okay start stimulation.
- 2. Consult & tests ~4-5 days later (determined by doctor after first consult; dependent upon when the stimulation started)
- 3. Consult & Tests another ~4-5 days later (determined by doctor after previous consult; dependent upon your response to stimulation)
- 4. Then either;
  - A. Trigger injection OR
- B. continued stimulation and a further consult 1-2 days (determined by doctor after previous consult; dependent upon your response to stimulation)
- 5. If 4. B. then followed by trigger injection.
- 6. ~36 hours after trigger injection is the egg retrieval (OPU) (and semen collection if fresh sperm) (Day 0 of embryo culture)
- 7. 5 days later (Day 5 of embryo culture) potential biopsy and PGD-CGH. If fresh transfer is required, result and potential embryo transfer next day. If no fresh transfer is required, embryos frozen pending results.
- 8. Next day (Day 6 of embryo culture), if further suitable embryos, potential biopsy and PGD-CGH; Embryos frozen pending results.
- 9. Once results are complete, only embryos of suitable genetics will be kept frozen.
